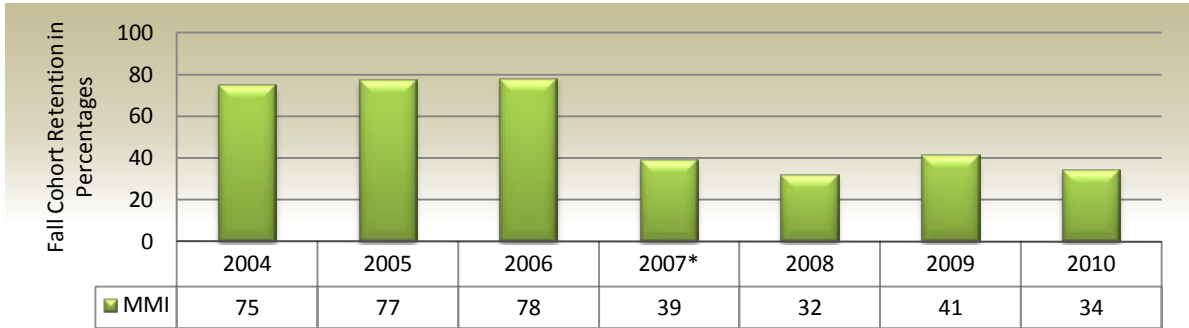


Data presented in the chart below represents IPEDS reported fall cohort retention data. The significant drop came about after becoming part of the Alabama Community College System and is due to a reporting issue. Prior to merging with the Alabama Community College System (ACCS) MMI's Service Academy Preparatory (SAP) Program completers were allowed in the retention calculations. As of 2007, after MMI became part of the ACCS, this student group was disallowed. The program has been under review by the State Board of Education and has now been officially recognized as a Military Technology Certificate Program. The inclusion of SAP completers in retention rates will begin fall of 2011.

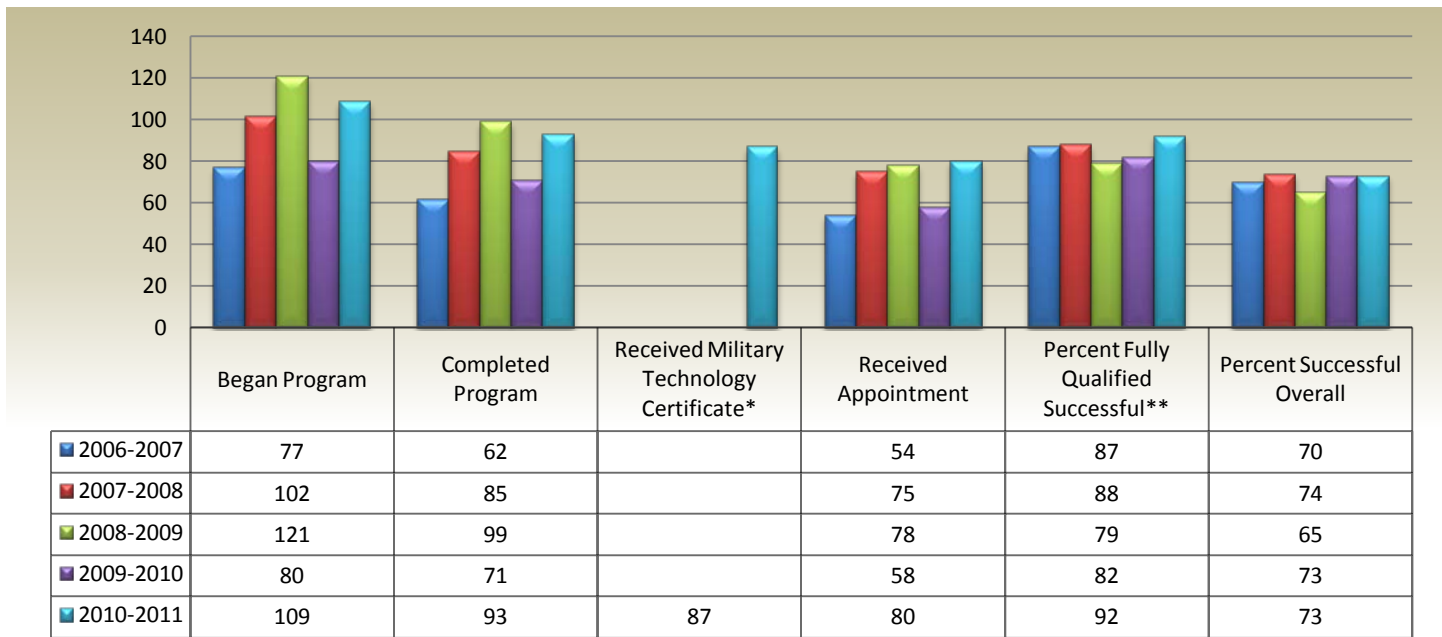
MMI Historical Retention Data

Data presented in the chart below depicts the actual number of cadets who began the SAP program, completed the program, and the number that received Academy Appointments. From 2006-07 through 2009-10 the term "Fully Qualified" denoted cadets that completed the program and were medically qualified for Academy appointments. From 2010-11 forward this will also include the award of the Military Technology Certificate. The overall success percentage is all inclusive and is based on the number of students that began the program and received their appointment.
