There were no institutional scholarships awarded to Wrestling Team members.

Another disclosure requirement for institutions participating in Title IV HEA Student Financial Aid Programs is to report the graduation and transfer-out rates of the first-time, full-time, degree-seeking undergraduates, categorized by race and gender for the most recently completing class as reported in the IPEDS Graduation Rate survey.

Of the 409 college students enrolled at Marion Military Institute in **Fall 2011**, two hundred seventy-one (271) constitute the full-time/first-time degree-seeking cohort. Within 150% of normal time, 27% graduated from MMI with an associate degree and another 43% were confirmed transfers to one of the US Service Academies (as completers of the SAP program) or another 4-year institution. Combined Graduation/Transfer rate for the 2011 cohort was 70%.
